



TUBERCULOSIS (TB) CLEARANCE REQUIREMENT

New students who arrive in Austria **less than three (3) months prior** to their school start date are required to submit official documentation confirming that the student does not have active tuberculosis. The TB clearance has to be stamped and signed by a health authority or doctor, translated into either English or German, and **cannot be older than three (3) months** at the time your child starts classes at ICSV.

Since this process can take several weeks, it is important to plan accordingly as your child **cannot start classes** until the school has received the requested documentation to confirm that your child does not have tuberculosis.

Official documentation may be obtained by one of the three options below:

1. **Physician's check** (submit medical form completed by student's physician)
2. **Skin Test** (Mendel Mantoux-test)
Note: *Children who have been immunized for tuberculosis* will most likely show a false positive with a skin test and then are required to have a follow-up chest x-ray to determine if the disease is active. A negative test result is required to start school.
3. **Chest X-ray**

All three options may be done prior to arriving in Austria if less than three (3) months before the student's start date. Otherwise, it may be completed after arriving in Austria. For your convenience, Vienna clinics providing TB tests are listed on the back of this letter.

Documentation should be submitted to the Admissions Office by email (admissions@icsv.at) or uploaded to the online admissions portal Open Apply (icsv.openapply.com) prior the student's start date.
